**Clues that this is a magazine or journal article:**

- *There is no publisher name or place listed*
- *There are two titles (article title and journal title).*
- *There is a volume # given (may also give an issue number)*
- *It is only a few pages long (not long enough to be a book)*

## Newspaper Article—no author given

**Clues that this is a newspaper article:**

- *Page number includes a letter indicating what section of the newspaper it is in*
- *Lack of an author often (but not always) indicates it is a newspaper article*
- *Dates for journals and books are usually just the year, not the month, day and year*

- *There is only one title.*
- *A place of publication and a publisher is listed.*

*Clues that this is a book chapter:*

- *There are two titles (chapter title and book title).*
- *There are two separate author/editor listings (author of chapter & author of book)*
- *A place of publication and a publisher is listed.*
